



THE UNIVERSITY OF CHICAGO MEDICAL CENTER PARKING RATES

The University of Chicago Medical Center provides parking for patients and visitors in its garage located on Maryland Avenue across from the Bernard Mitchell Hospital entrance.

Patients and visitors have the option of self-parking or using UCMC valet services. Valet services are available at the entrances of Bernard Mitchell Hospital and the Duchossois Center for Advanced Medicine (DCAM). Patients and visitors may purchase coupon books for discounted parking rates.

Effective July 1, 2007 parking rates for these services are as follows:

BLUE PRE-PAID COUPONS

SELF PARK -- 24 hours: 1 Coupon (no in and out privileges)

VALET -- Less than 3 hours: 1 Coupon / VALET -- 3 hours to 24 hours: 2 Coupons

To be eligible for the discount rates, simply have a "Patient and Family" validation placed on your parking ticket at the clinic, admissions office, or DCAM 1st floor security desk.

Coupon booklets are for patients and their families only. They can be purchased for \$25 (a book of 5 coupons) or \$50 (a book of 10 coupons) at the following locations:

AMENITIES

HANDICAPPED PARKING

Several spaces have been designated on the ground level of the main garage for handicap access parking as well as various spaces throughout the garage. These spaces are for use only by visitors and patients with a state-issued handicap permit. No exceptions will be made to this policy.

RESERVED/ASSIGNED PARKING

The University of Chicago Medical Center has reserved and assigned parking spaces for the exclusive use of clinicians and medical personnel. Parking in these spaces by unauthorized patients, visitors and staff is prohibited. AUTOMOBILE ASSISTANCE

The University of Chicago Medical Center provides the following services to patients and visitors using our parking facilities between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:30 p.m. Please contact the parking office at (773) 702-4381 for automobile assistance.

EMERGENCY JUMP STARTING

If your vehicle fails to start due to a battery problem, the Parking staff is equipped to jump-start your vehicle.

TIRE INFLATION/REPAIR

In the event your tires need inflating or you need a flat repaired, please contact the Parking staff.

LOCK-OUT SERVICE

In the event you should be locked out of your vehicle, the Parking staff can assist with most vehicles.

LOCATION OF LOST VEHICLE

Parking staff is trained in assisting you to locate your vehicles if you've forgotten where you have parked.

SECURITY

The University of Chicago Medical Center is committed to providing a safe and secure environment for our patients and visitors. To ensure your safety in our parking facilities, we have located duress alarms on every floor of the garage. For your added protection, closed circuit TV cameras are installed in various areas of the South and DCAM garages. Our Security staff also provides additional services such as escort services and after-hour jump-starts. Please call the Security office at (773) 702-6262 to request the following services:

ESCORT SERVICES

When special circumstances make you feel uneasy about leaving the security of our building, we can assist you. Call the Security office to request someone to escort you to your vehicle.

AFTER HOURS JUMP STARTS

If your vehicle fails to start due to a problem with the battery, the Security staff provides emergency jump-starts between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.
