The FBI has concluded their investigation into the threat against the University of Chicago. As we indicated earlier, a suspect has been arrested and this afternoon the United States Attorney's Office announced that charges have been brought against the individual who is suspected of posting the threat online.

In light of this, normal operations will resume for UCMC and BSD on Tuesday, December 1. All staff should report to work per their normal shift/assignment tomorrow morning. The garages will resume business operations with access to monthly parkers, patients and visitors.
