

IMPORTANT INFORMATION – PLEASE READ

Dear Patient,

Thank you for choosing the University of Chicago Medicine for your health care needs. We deeply value our relationship with you and we are committed to making sure our great medical care is available to as many people as possible.

Beginning January 1, 2018, the state changed its Medicaid program to require all patients under Medicaid be covered by a managed care health plan. This is part of a strategy, started several years ago, to broaden managed care across the entire state. Managed care is designed to improve quality of care while at the same time control costs. This new, larger Medicaid program is called HealthChoice Illinois.

The University of Chicago Medicine and the University of Chicago Physicians Group will remain in-network with ONLY the following HealthChoice Illinois plans:

- IlliniCare Health – 1 (866) 329-4701
- CountyCare (Cook County residents only) – 1 (312) 864-8200

If you already participate in one of the above plans, you need to do nothing to continue getting your care at UChicago Medicine.

If you are not now in one of these plans, and want to receive medical care from us, you must switch to one of these plans by March 31, 2018.
